

Terms and Conditions for HSBC Silver Bond Subscription Services and Fee Handling

(Service period: 30 Sep 2024 – 14 Oct 2024)

Important Risk Warning

1. Bonds are investment products. The investment decision is yours.

1. The service period is from **30 September 2024 to 14 October 2024** (both dates inclusive) (unless otherwise specified below).

The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Limited in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region ("HKSAR") (and its successors and assigns) (the "Bank") will waive the handling fee as referred below if a customer successfully subscribed Silver Bond during the Service Period (the "Eligible Customers")
3. The services provided by the Bank in respect of the subscription of Silver Bonds described herein are subject to the prevailing regulatory requirements. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Bank shall be final and conclusive.
4. The Bank reserves the right to change these Terms and Conditions at any time and the offers may be withdrawn or terminated by the Bank at its discretion without prior notice. The Bank accepts no liability for any such change, withdrawal or termination.
5. No person other than the Eligible Customer and the Bank will have any right under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Ordinance to enforce or enjoy the benefit of any of the provisions of these Terms and Conditions.
6. All remarks and footnotes stated in all relevant materials are intended to serve as part of the Terms and Conditions. If there is any conflict between the information contained in the remarks and footnotes and the Terms and Conditions set out herein, the Terms and Conditions set out herein shall apply and prevail.
7. In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between the Chinese and English versions of these Terms and Conditions, the English version shall apply and prevail.
8. The services provided in these terms and conditions are held within the HKSAR. All the Terms and Conditions listed herein shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of HKSAR and each participant submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of HKSAR.

Terms and Conditions for the handling fee waiver

1. Eligible Customers are eligible for the handling fee waiver for any subscription of Silver Bond from **30 September 2024 to 14 October 2024**.
2. The fee waiver includes the waivers for subscription handling fee, safe custody fee, interest collection fee, early redemption fee and redemption at maturity fee for the allocated Silver Bond.



Risk Disclosure

Factors affecting market price of bonds include, and are not limited to, fluctuations in interest rates, credit spreads, and liquidity premiums. The fluctuation in yield generally has a greater effect on prices of longer tenor bonds. There is an inherent risk that losses may be incurred rather than profit made as a result of buying and selling bonds.
5. There may be exchange rate risks if you choose to convert payments made on the bond to your home currency.
6. If bonds are early redeemed, you may not be able to enjoy the same rates of return when you use the funds to purchase other products.
